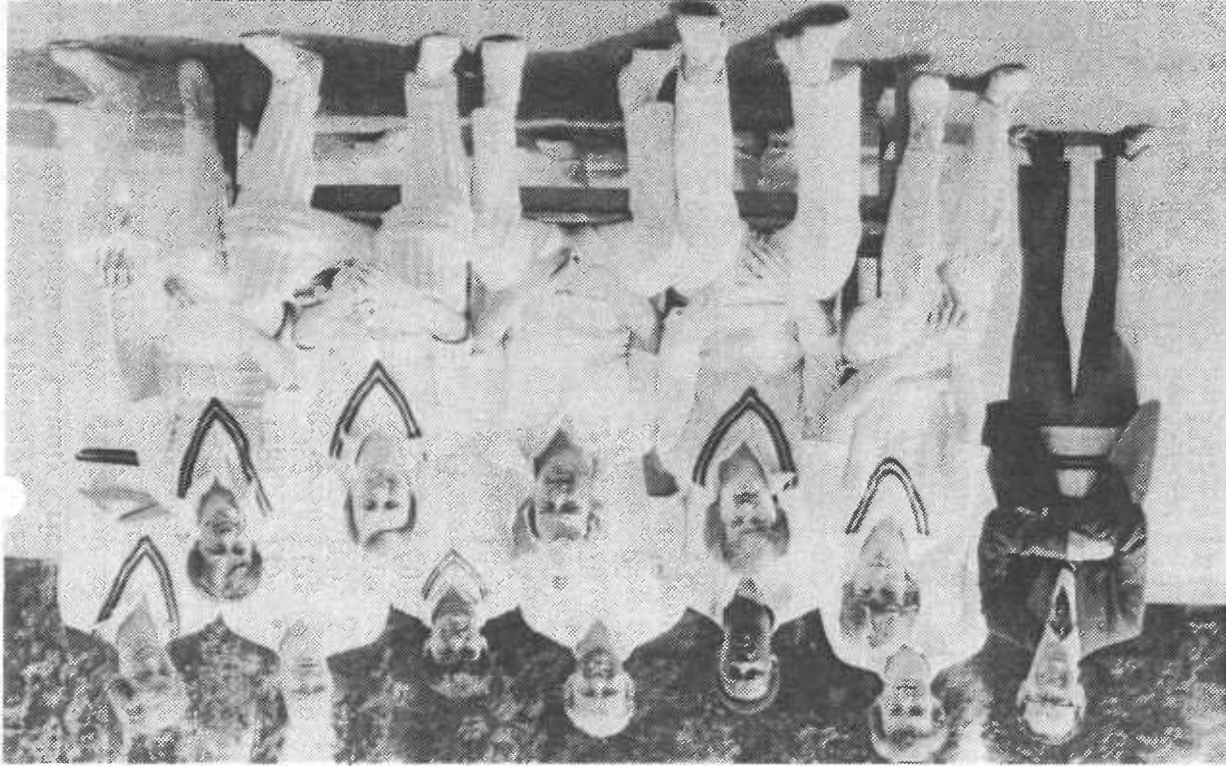

BRENTHAM COLTS

The Colts Section is affiliated to the Middlesex Colts Cricket Association. The Association was founded in 1966 and Brentham joined during the early Seventies. The initial effort in establishing and organising our Colts was undertaken by David Frewer with assistance from Fred Bailey and a few members of the Club.

Initially we entered into the U.17 and U.15 leagues which was soon followed by the U.13's. In 1978 we joined the U.11 league and are still one of the few clubs in Middlesex to take part in this age group.

During the past few years the number of boys joining us have shown a marked increase and we now have a junior membership of ninety boys.

Prior to colts cricket becoming organised in its present form, it must not be forgotten that in the past members of the Club gave up their time to organise friendlies against other Clubs. During the fifties, Paul Swann organised matches which encouraged many cricketers to play for the Club during the ensuing years.

The present organisation and coaching which is offered to boys has been reflected with our results on the field which can be seen from the following details:—

- 1979: Under 11 Middlesex County Champions.
- 1981: Under 13 Middlesex County Champions.
- 1980: Under 13 8-a-side Middlesex Indoor County Champions.
- 1980: Under 17 Mansell Knock Out Cup Winners.
- 1978: Under 15 South Area League Winners.
- 1981: Under 11 South Area League Winners.
