SEASON 1987

Tom Kerry was a member of the County Under 16's but regretfully was overlooked by the Middlesex Selectors. Also a number of the younger boys were attending County trials this winter.

1987 was my first year in charge of the administration for the colts and I would like to express my thanks and gratitude to all those who provided support and assistance in the past year in particular to Roy James, Ian Juster, David Frewer, Colin Cheadle, Paul Hooper, Pressana Pitale, Laurance James and Ray Lloyd.
